IONC has coordinated a response to Bill C-6 and has sent it to the Minister of Health, Honourable Leona Aglukkaq, as attached below.

If you have not read IONC's initial communication and explanation of Bill C-6 you will find it along with IONC's Letter in response to Bill C-6 written to the Minister of Health, and IONC's Petition to the Parliament of Ontario for your use, posted on our website shortly. www.ionc.org.

You are strongly encouraged to personally write your local MP and send in a petition, either the one prepared by IONC, with space to write your name as practitioner, or one of your own creation, with as many signatures from family, friends, clients and peers as possible. The petition must contain a minimum of 25 valid signatures to be presented to the House of Commons.
